

## **NUMISMATA conditions (AGB) of rental and participation**

The NUMISMATA International reserves domiciliary rights in the event rooms.

- 1.** The invoice is the confirmation for your reservation of an exhibition area, and payment is due in advance. In the event that payment is not made within the period allowed for payment, the NUMISMATA organizer can cancel the reservation. Exhibitor admission is from 8.00 a.m. The new opening hours for visitors are on Saturday from 9.30 a.m. until 5 p.m. and on Sunday from 9.30 a.m. until 3 p.m. The exhibitor is obliged to occupy his/her stand(s) and is not allowed to close the stand longer than a half an hour during the visitors opening hours. The exhibitor must be present to serve his customers until Sunday at least until 2.30 p.m. If an exhibitor is prevented of participation, the paid table rental fee expires. At participation cancellation after issue of our invoice we will levy a handling fee of 15% of the invoice amount. Step by step the fee will increase up to 100% if the cancellation will be later than 2 weeks before the beginning of the fair.
- 2.** Sublease of the rented area is not permitted. The organizer is entitled to carry out an identity check at any time. To obtain free entrance tickets for the persons, who do not work at the stand of the exhibitor is a cheat. Leased tables and booths are marked with nameplates and running numbers. No rearrangements are not allowed. The nameplates at the tables and boxes are not permitted be used as advertising area, changed by handwriting or stickers. At the end of the fair the exhibitor must remove affixed advertising material from the walls completely.
- 3.** The exhibitor is obliged to conclude commercially correct and respectable business transactions, e.g. to issue invoices and receipts. Offering imitations or fakes is regarded as an intention of deceit. It is prohibited to offer Euro-samples, Euro-imitations and medal coinages from 1970 on which have the feature to be mistaken for original coins. Influenced with a means of advertising materials or nice packing ups a customer can be deluded with ease and buy coins resembling items without realizing that. This kind of offers is a misuse of the inexperience of buyers, they are deceptive for collectors and trouble the market. We do not desire such vendors.
- 4.** On stands available objects, leaflets and advertising material dare represent only coins, ancient medals, ancient money, banknotes, ancient securities and shares, authentic objects from the antiquity as well as specialized literature and equipment. Display and distribution of any kind of material or documents outlying the exhibitor's leased area is prohibited.
- 5.** It is allowed to deal with cultural possessions only in the case if a documentary evidence of legal acquisition exists. It is prohibited to exhibit, to offer or to sell items like coins, orders, paper-money etc. with national socialist symbols like swastika etc., if these characteristics are shown visible and identifiable. This also applies to symbols which can be mistaken for originals. This contravention may be reported to the police.
- 6.** All activities which counteract the event, disturb, impede or defame the exhibition will result in immediate exclusion without details of reason and without refund of the stand fee. The contravention may be reported to the police.
- 7.** The organiser is not liable for damages caused to persons or objects, that may occur during the NUMISMATA without his fault, e.g. theft of goods, malfunction of technical facilities and damages caused by acts of god. If the fair can not take place by acts of god we will not recompense the stand fee. The organizer is also disengaged from amends for lost objects which are expected from a forwarder or are destined for a forwarder.
- 8.** Exhibitors who travel with visa are permitted to sales activity on the NUMISMATA only as a bearer of a valid business visa - not with tourist visa! Exhibitors from the states which are not member of the EU are referred to the valid value added tax or import sales tax.
- 9.** The organizer reserves the right to select exhibitors to provide a variety of offer. It depends among other things on range and quality of numismatic articles. No applicant can lay claim to be admitted in participation as an exhibitor. It is also valid in case of overbooking or offence against our terms and conditions. All business happens beyond the responsibility of the organizer.
